"Serenity" is about reconnecting to nature, community, and to ones self. It is a kinetic, glass and metal sculpture created for the Jim Gilmore Jr. Community Healing Center, Kalamazoo, MI. The work is designed to communicate an experience of peacefulness.

"Serenity" is a vertical landscape, starting from below the surface of the lake through the horizon up into the sky. It is a picture you can view in 360 degrees by carefully moving the glass.

The design shows a family of similar forms in different sizes that when together create an arc that captures light and reaches toward the sky. The group of sculptures can be rearranged in a multitude of configurations creating a special experience when the viewer walks around them. Each component of the sculpture and lighting is designed using materials of high durability and low maintenance.

Each sculpture is a custom project based on your unique requirements: site, numbers of sculptures in the grouping, shape, size, colors, etc.

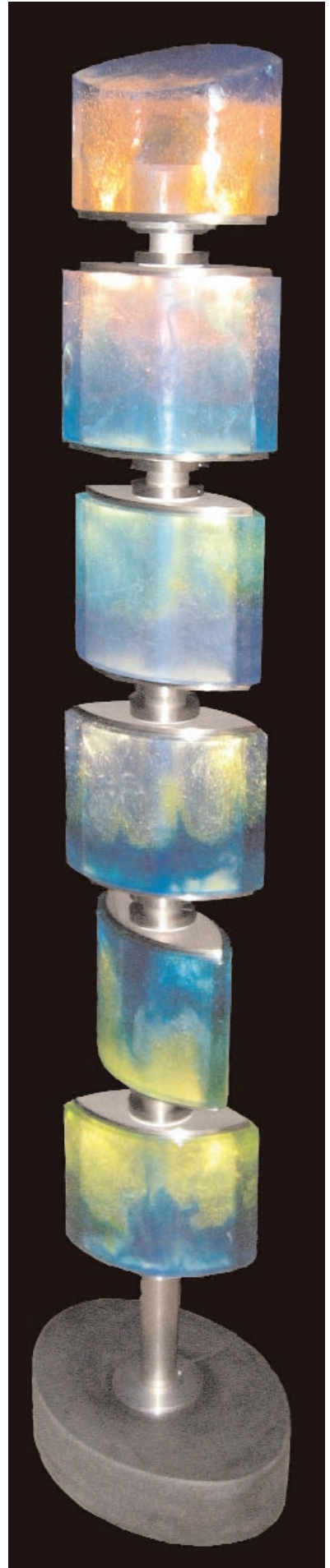
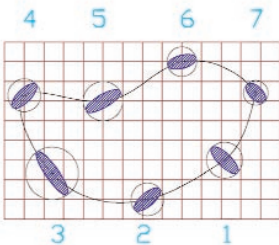
